

Why are there costs?

- The IMPACT Centre is part of the Queensland Government's Department of Education.
- Department of Education leaders asked our centre to create a school-funded model so that each school can match its improvement agenda to our initiatives and invest accordingly.
- The IMPACT Centre operates on a cost-recovery model, with salaries and operational costs fully-funded by investing schools.



Professional networks

- Premium professional networks empower educators to lead high priority initiatives across your school.
 - Options include [Aspiring STEM Specialists](#), [Aspiring Thinkers](#) and [IMPACT Innovators](#).
 - Membership of a premium professional network costs **\$950 per person**.
 - Membership is valid for 12 months from your joining date, and includes access to a foundational two-day workshop, one full-day masterclass per term and ongoing online workshops and collaboration with like-minded colleagues and experts in the field.
- [Capability Squad](#) membership is free for your staff during the rounds that your students participate in our U2B writing or numeracy projects. Squads introduce your teachers to the skills/strategies your students are learning – the aim is for the students and teachers to transfer this learning to class.

Student programs – FTE or cash

- Schools invest using a small fraction of FTE, or cash, or a combination.
- Schools register groups of students in projects of their choice. There are 14 students in a group.
- The cost of a group is fixed. There is no reduction in cost if you do not fill the group because we resource the group in the same way as a full group.

Option 1: Invest FTE – register by *Monday 19 November, 2018*.

No. of groups	No. of students	FTE Fraction
3 groups for the year	42 places for the year	0.1 FTE
6 groups for the year	84 places for the year	0.2 FTE
9 groups for the year	126 places for the year	0.3 FTE
12 groups for the year	168 places for the year	0.4 FTE
15 groups for the year	210 places for the year	0.5 FTE

- Your school transfers the agreed FTE fraction to the IMPACT Centre via School Budgeting Solution (SBS). We will provide instructions and timelines after registration.
- Your school can switch to the equivalent cash option if your Day 8 2019 numbers necessitate a change – ensure that you budget for this if it is a possibility.
- Additional costs may apply to your FTE investment:
 - Each participating student must use a headset with microphone. View details [here](#).
 - Participation in some STEM projects incurs an additional cash charge e.g.:
 - electronic coding kits for coding projects.
 - excursion costs for marine project – venue entry plus transport to and from venue.

Option 2: Invest cash

- Many schools use [Investing for Success \(I4S\)](#) funds or general school budget allocations.
- Many secondary schools use HOD or departmental budgets to target specific initiatives.
- Some schools ask parents or community organisations to partially or fully contribute.
- We invoice your school to collect payment.
- Additional costs may apply – see headset and STEM details in FTE section above.

Option 2A: Invest cash to participate in **all three rounds** - by Monday 19 November, 2018.

No. of groups	No. of students	Cash Amount @ \$3990 per group
3 groups for the year	42 places for the year	\$11 970
6 groups for the year	84 places for the year	\$23 940
9 groups for the year	126 places for the year	\$35 910

- This option is discounted compared to 2B and 2C to encourage investment across all three rounds.
- Your school can develop pathways across all three rounds for cohorts, groups or individual students e.g., Years 7 and 9 in Round 1, then Years 8 and 10 in Rounds 2-3 or the same group of students all year.

Option 2B: Invest cash to participate in **one or two rounds** - by Monday 19 November, 2018.

No. of groups	No. of students	Cash Amount @ \$4130 per group
1 group in a round	14 places	\$4 130
2 groups in a round	28 places	\$8 260
3 groups in a round	42 places	\$12 390
4 groups in a round	56 places	\$16 520

- This option is discounted compared to 2C to encourage early registration - so we can recruit and train our staff in advance.
- You can upgrade your initial investment e.g. register now but choose to invest further during 2019.

Option 2C: Invest cash to participate in **one or two rounds** - **after** Monday 19 November, 2018.

No. of groups	No. of students	Cash Amount @ \$4340 per group
1 group in a round	14 places	\$4 340
2 groups in a round	28 places	\$8 680
3 groups in a round	42 places	\$13 020
4 groups in a round	56 places	\$17 360

- You can upgrade your initial investment e.g. register now but choose to invest further during 2019.
